DE LA SALLE SCHOLAR EVENTS & BENEFITS

In addition to their rigorous academic schedule, De La Salle Scholars are involved in many events and other opportunities on campus and in the community, including the following:

- Career Day Host Scholars receive priority registration and have the opportunity to network with alumni at a special breakfast.
- College Road Tour Scholars have priority registration for the week long college road tour visiting up to ten universities. Rising sophomore scholars are the only sophomores invited to participate.
- Job Shadowing Alumni host junior and senior scholars at their job sites giving them first hand experience with potential career choices.
- Executive Lunches Through these small group lunches with alumni, students discover more about careers and educational pathways. Scholars have priority registration.
- Peer Academic Mentoring Scholars are expected to serve their community with their academic gifts by being academic peer mentors, volunteering at our tutoring labs, or tutoring elementary students.
- PSAT Prep PSAT practice sessions are provided for scholars.

BECOMING A DE LA SALLE SCHOLAR

GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

- Total of 12 honors/AP credits from sophomore to senior year (AP courses count as 1.5 credits)
- Cumulative 4.0 GPA maintained through the end of 7th semester
- Three years of service in one service area
- Participated in De La Salle Scholar community service activities and peer tutoring programs
- Demonstrated leadership experience
